GENERAL RULES FOR GUIDANCE OF CADETS

1	Cadets must wish the ladies, members of the staff and visitors followed by 'Sir' or 'Madam' and salute service officers followed by Jai Hind Sir.
2	They must keep perfect silence while : (a) Fall- in (b) Stepping into the school main building, particularly in Vivekanand Auditorium, Classrooms, laboratories and during preparatory periods. (c) In the dining-hall. (d) In the Houses after 2100hrs.
3	They must safeguard the property of school. Any damage observed must be brought the notice of Class teacher/ House Master /Duty Master of the day immediately.
4	They must be "punctual" and reach well in time for all activities.
5	No Cadet should leave the school campus without prior Permission from Vice Principal/ Sr Master.
6	Cadet must not tease Bees or pluck leaves and flowers from the garden.
7	They must be polite at all the times in their dealings with friends, seniors, strangers and ladies.
8	They must always talk in ENGLISH.
9	They must write letters / make phone calls to their parents regularly, at least, once a week.
10.	Cadets are not permitted to keep mobile phones/tablet etc.
11.	Cadets are to wear Head Gear in uniform at all times whenever they are outside of the classroom/Houses/Mess

12.	They must observe proper dress code while in the school building, in the Cadets' Mess or at the play fields / training area.
13.	Cadets should not use foul language/Sarcastic remarks/Hurt religious sentiments/ ill treat/emotional blackmail/ in-fight/ Man handle/Peer Pressure for wrong deeds against any cadets in any form.
14.	Ragging is strictly prohibited.
15.	Cadets will not visit the out of bound areas such as cook house, without any valid reason,River and any such areas outside the school premises.
16.	No party/ celebration is to be organized in the Houses.

TURN-OUT AND HYGIENE

Cadets must maintain a neat and smart appearance at all times. For this they should:-

1	Brush their teeth daily twice- once in the morning and once before going to bed.
2	Keep their finger and toe nails trimmed and clean.
3	Take bath every day.
4	Take their hair- cut twice a month.
5	Comb their hair properly.
6	Polish their shoes every day.
7	Wash their socks and under garments every day.
8	Dress-up for various activities as per rules.
9.	Keep their sleeves down in Mufti.
10.	Always be in appropriate shoes other than shoe excuse by Medical Authority.

DORMITORY DISCIPLINE

1	<p>Cadets are forbidden to.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Enter their dorms during working hours.(ii) Borrow or lend money.(iii) Keep valuable items with them including Mobiles etc.(iv) Bring eatable inside the dormitory.
2	<p>They should mark their garments and mend/stitch buttons on Sundays.</p>
3	<p>Cadets should remember to.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Visit the toilet before going to bed.(ii) Make their beds once before going to sleep and again after waking up.(iii) Close the water taps, when not in use.(iv) Flush the latrines after use.(v) Switch- off fans and lights when not required.(vi) Cadets should use their own soap and towel.
4	<p>They should carry-out orders and instructions passed by school through Appointments.</p>

CLASS - ROOM DISCIPLINE

1	<u>When a teacher goes to take a class, the monitor will bring the class to "Savdhan" and handover the Parade State to the teacher.</u>
2	The class-room furniture and walls must be kept clean and tidy. Damage, if any, should be immediately brought to the notice of the class teacher by monitor.
3	Whenever the class goes out, the class-rooms must be switched-off. All lights and fans
4	Whenever doors and windows are opened, these must be properly secured with stoppers.

MESS DISCIPLINE

1	Cadets should reach the mess on time and in proper dress.
2	Each meal will begin and end with a prayer. Cadets must stand in attention for the prayer.
3	Cadets should not start eating or drinking water till the prayer has been completed.
4	Silence should be maintained in the mess.
5	Cadets should not waste food.
6	Cadets should learn and observe mess etiquettes.
7	Cadets should not argue with the waiters/mess staff.
8	Cadets should not compel the waiters to serve them anything which is not on menu.
9	Cadets should leave the mess only after the Grace.

DUTIES OF THE HOUSE CAPTAIN

1.	Will himself set a good example in turn-out, punctuality and good behavior for all cadets of his house.
2.	Will promote a spirit of honor and sportsmanship among the boys of his house.
3.	Will explain relevant school orders to the cadets of his house and ensure that they are fully carried out.
4.	Will deposit the "Lost & Found" property with the Administrative Officer.
5.	Will keep close liaison with all the prefects of his house & guide and help them in carrying-out their duties.

DUTIES OF THE CLASS MONITOR

1.	Class Monitor will be responsible to the Class teacher for the following :-
(a)	Ensure discipline in the class.
(b)	Ensure that class room is cleaned daily and waste paper is put in the Dust bin.
(c)	Ensure that chalk and duster are available in the class- room.
(d)	Maintain the inventory of furniture and electric fittings in the class-room.
(e)	Ensure that the class-room is locked after school hours and whenever the cadets move out for any reason during working hours.
(f)	Arrange issue of stationery and books.
(g)	Will report any loss of breakage immediately to the class teacher.
(h)	Ensure that Light and Fans are switched off when cadets move out of the classrooms.
(j)	Will ensure the smart class equipments fixed in the classes are functioning properly.
(k)	Will bring the class to Savdhan whenever Teacher/Adm Offr/Vice Principal/Principal enter in to the class.
(l)	Will have the accountability of every cadet of the class.
(m)	Must maintain the following records on daily basis. (i) Split-up syllabus. (ii) Monitor the progress of the syllabus as per split up syllabus (iii) Period wise attendance of the students.

DUTIES OF THE CLASS ASSISTANT MONITOR

1.	Will assist the monitor in discharge of his duties.
2.	Will fill the attendance of the class in the I-period in the column on the black-board/glass-board and keep it up-to date in each period.

VISITORS

Parents and authorized visitors are permitted to meet the cadets only on from 1100 hrs to 1600 hrs. They should enter their particulars in the register kept with the Hostel Superintendent. They should also enter the time of arrival, and departure. They should enter dormitories only after obtaining specific permission from the House Master/Duty Master

PRINCIPAL'S TURNOUT INSPECTION

Turn out inspection will be carried out on first Monday of the month. 1 Point will be awarded for each good turn out and negative mark will be awarded for unsatisfactory turn out. Points thus scored will contribute towards Inter House Championship Banner. Following will be taken into consideration:-

- (a) General hygiene and cleanliness of the cadets.
- (b) Proper turnout and hair cut of the cadets.
- (c) Command and control of the leader.

PRINCIPAL'S INSPECTION OF HOUSES.

The following will be inspected.

- (a) Cleanliness.
- (b) Kit lay-out in the house.
- (c) Maintenance of the house including electrical/water and sanitary fittings.
- (d) General development of the surrounding areas including house garden.
- (e) During Principal's Inspection the Hostel Supdt / Matron, Day Warden will be present.
